I. ADMISSION

Admissions are granted to all classes subject to availability of vacancies.

Admissions will be decided on the basis of tests and interviews. For admission to L.K.G., the child should have 4 years of age completed on 31st March of the year in which the admissions is sought. Those seeking admission to higher classes should fulfill the corresponding age requirement. The Transfer Certificate & Birth Certificate should be submitted along with the admission application.

V. ATTENDANCE

Every student is required to have an attendance of not less than 90% of the total number of working days in the academic year. If a student is continuously absent for more than 15 days without sanction in writing, his/her name shall be cut off from the rolls. Application for leave should be submitted in the format of Leave Record given in the school diary and duly signed by parents. Application for leave for more than 3 days should be submitted to the Principal. Application for leave on medical grounds should be countersigned by an appropriate medical authority with the official seal affixed. Any student suffering from a contagious disease will not be allowed to attend the school. Withdrawal of children from classes during school hours is not permitted, except in the case of emergency.

VI. SCHOOL FEE - REMITTANCE

Tuition Fee is to be paid for 10 months in Five Installments in July, September, November, January, March. The payment can be made without Fine upto 10th but with fine of Rs. 10/- till 15th, Rs. 20/- till 25th and Rs. 50/- till 30th of the month of payment. Fee defaulters for more than 3 months will be terminated from rolls without any notice. Such students would be re-admitted subject to vacancies and payment of all dues plus re-admission charge of Rs. 50/-. There shall be fee increase from time to time in commensurate with the Development of the school's Infrastructure as well as the salary hike.

VII. VISITING TIME FOR PARENTS

- a. Teachers : On all Working Days between 3.15 p.m. to 3.45 p.m. with prior appointment.
- b. Principal : On all Working Days between 9.30 a.m. to 10.30 a.m. and 2.45 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.

VIII. EXAMINATION & PROMOTION

As per the CBSE directive a system of Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) is being followed from class I to X.

CRITERIA FOR PROMOTION

Promotion from class I to X will be based on the Rules and Regulations presented by the CBSE.

- * If a student fails in the same class twice, the parent will be advised to withdraw the student.
- * If any student is found using unfair means during the examination, that answer-paper of the erring student shall be cancelled and he/she will be awarded 'Zero' for that paper.

GENERAL SCHOOL RULES

THIS DIARY SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO SCHOOL EVERYDAY

1. Instructions given in this diary should be promptly and properly carried out. The diary should not be used as a rough book and pages there from not torn.
2. Children should be present in the school campus before 08.40 am and leave soon after 3.00 pm whether in the school or private buses. They should not stand in groups in the school premises. No student is allowed to stay back without the Principals permission.
3. **It is compulsory to speak in English while in the campus/ school bus.**
4. **They should be polite and courteous and should greet teachers, elders and guests.**
5. **Use of abusive language or gesture is strictly prohibited.**

6. As you are aware, the Government has strictly banned the use of mobile phones by the students in schools. Parents are directed not to permit their wards taking mobile phones to the school campus. It is made clear that if detected, the student shall be removed from the rolls forthwith and no excuses or explanations shall be entertained.
7. School property has to be taken proper care of damages of any kind may have to be got rectified by payment of fine.

SCHOOL DISCIPLINE

“Confidence comes from discipline and training’. Only a well groomed and disciplined child can grow up into an intrinsically disciplined adult with the right value system and attitude.

Santa Cruz public School has been trying its best to inculcate the right values, attitude and self discipline in its children. Needless to say the role of parents in setting the right example and guiding the child properly is of utmost importance.

FOR PARENTS

Effective school discipline starts from effective home discipline. Parents are always encouraged to work with the school to try and solve any problems that may arise. The school expects the full co-operation of parents in matters of discipline.

PARENTS ARE REQUESTED...

- a. to look into the school diary of their wards and ensure that the home assignments are duly completed by their wards. Remarks made by the teachers should be acknowledged by the parents.
- b. to establish a good rapport with all teachers.
- c. to sent an authorization letter with the person in case of any inconvenience from their side. No student will be sent home with a stranger even in the case of emergency.

- d. to intimate the school office for any change of address or telephone numbers to enable us to contact the parents quickly in case of necessity.
- e. not to use the school diary to send communications to the school.
- f. to see that their wards come to school smart and tidy and in complete uniform.
- g. to monitor the activity of their wards after school hours.
- h. not to entrust large amount of money with their wards.
- i. to be available whenever they are needed as in the case of sickness, signing warning letters and other disciplinary matters.
- j. **not to visit the faculty rooms or classrooms.**
- k. to see that their wards return the library books on time.

STUDENTS ARE ADVISED TO STRICTLY ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- a. All students are responsible for their own action
- b. Attend school regularly. Be punctual and be prepared to work to the best of their ability.
- c. Respect the rights and property of others
- d. Not to leave school without permission
- e. Move about in the campus in an orderly manner. Running and shouting in the corridors are not acceptable
- f. Not to enjoy any school facility other than they regularly avail without prior permission
- g. Maintain discipline while they travel in public or public transport.
- h. Not to roam about in the school uniform after the school hours

- i. Without prior permission cd's, pendrives, cameras are not allowed
- j. Children are not permitted to bring, borrow, lend or exchange any fancy or costly articles
- k. Santa Cruz aims at making the campus a completely plastic free zone. Kindly co-operate with us by providing,
 - i) Only Steel Tiffin boxes and water bottles .
 - ii) Sweets and chocolates are prohibited in the campus
 - iii) Celebrate birthdays by planting a sapling in the campus or donating a book to the library instead of sweets or chocolates
- l. Shouting , whistling, teasing, showing disrespect, enmity towards anyone and telling lies are signs of bad character and therefore are strictly prohibited
- m. No student is expected to indulge in any form of ragging. If found so strict action will be taken against such erring students as per the ragging act implemented by the state of Kerala
- n. Bullying inside the campus is strictly prohibited
- o. Paper bits and unwanted things are to be deposited in the dustbin only
- p. No student is allowed to bring stickers, sweets, toys, cards, money etc. to the classroom
- q. Students shall not enter or leave the class during the class hours without the permission of the teacher.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Our school believes in simplicity and modesty. The dignity of the dress code should be maintained both by boys and girls

- a. ID cards are issued from the school and every student should wear it daily to school.

- b. Children should come to school in clean and properly ironed uniforms.
- c. Girls should tie their long hair in two plaits. Girls should compulsorily wear tights and long petticoats. Boys should trim their hair short. The school doesn't entertain any fancy hairstyles. Colouring of hair is not allowed. Senior boys should come clean shaved.
- d. The uniforms should be properly stitched as per the school requirements. Boys should tuck their shirts in and wear school uniform belts. In no case can they wear 'low waist trousers'.
- e. Girls skirt should reach below the knees.
- f. No fancy foot wear is permitted. During rainy days children should wear black sandals.
- g. Students should not wear/use gold ornaments, fancy jewelleryes, nail polish, lip gloss and perfume.

BUS RULES

- 1. The smaller children should be seated before the senior students occupy the seats.
- 2. Students should remove their bags from their shoulders before boarding the bus and keep them neatly on the racks.
- 3. All school bus stops are codified and the buses will stop only at the designated stops. The bus departure timings at the stops can be obtained from the School Office. The buses may reach the bus stop 5 minutes before the scheduled departure time and will leave immediately after all the students from the particular bus stop board the bus. However the buses will not wait for students beyond the scheduled departure time. Bus users are expected to be at the respective bus stops, 5 minutes before the scheduled departure time of the bus.

4. Communications from parents to the School shall be only in writing and oral instructions to bus crew will not be entertained. Buses shall not be detained at bus stops for this purpose.
5. Occasionally it may not be possible to run the buses along the designated routes due to traffic blocks or regulations by the Traffic Authorities. Under such circumstances, the bus crew will intimate the Parents who are available at the boarding points, the nearest bus stop where the school bus can drop the children during the return trip. The children can be brought back to the bus terminus if parents desire to pick them up from there. Information on alternative arrangements can be obtained from the School Office also.
6. Unless otherwise communicated to the parents in advance, the buses will not leave the school earlier than the scheduled departure time on any day.
7. Students can use only the trip that is allotted to them. Children will be brought back to the school if the parents / guardian are not available to receive them at the bus stops.
8. Students are not permitted to change their bus routes / bus stops.
9. Children who wish to withdraw bus facility should intimate in writing one month in advance.

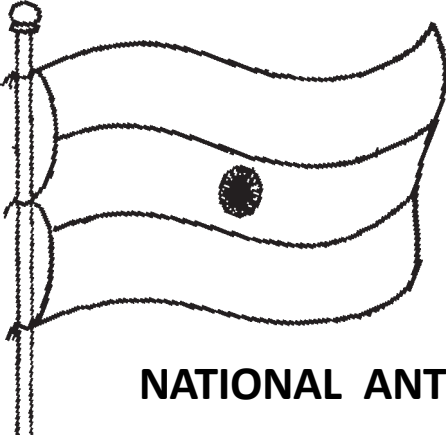
