I take immense pleasure to present the Annual Day report of our school. We have always been committed to create an environment in the school which help the young minds to blossom and provide a platform for individual thinking and holistic development of a child's personality.

First Staff meeting was conducted in May. Class charges and duties were allotted. Decided to have monthly test which will help in the academic improvement. Ms. Anisha Riya was selected as staff secretary.

Admissions to LKG was closed before April 30th. In other classes also we limited the intake of students in May. Now we have 1066 students in our school. KG section -284 & Public school -782.

Class X Result 2022-23

This year also we achieved 100% result. 43 students wrote the exam. Highest score is 91.4%. It was a great achievement.

Book distribution and Wednesday uniform distribution started on 23rd May. School diary was distributed on June 2nd

School reopened for std. 1-10 on June 1st. Std. 1 students were welcomed with a band from KG to public school with paper smily.
